Thomas makes Scandinavian move

WA SCHOOL of Mines graduate Paul Thomas has been appointed as a non-executive director of Scandinavian Resources. Originally qualifying as a metallurgist, Mr Thomas subsequently attained various other regulatory and technical qualifications in mining, processing, management and finance.

Mr Thomas became the OMH Group's chief development officer in March 2010 and, with 25 years in the industry, is a member of the Australian Institute of Company Directors and a senior associate of the Financial Services Institute of Australasia.

Meanwhile, Sandfire Resources has appointed experienced corporate and commercial lawyer, Derek La Ferla, as non-executive chairman, as the company moves ahead with development of its DeGrussa Copper-Gold Project.

Mr La Ferla is a senior corporate partner of Norton Rose in its Perth office.

Quest Minerals has appointed renowned geologist Dr Dennis Gee as a non-executive director.
